Dear Pastor and Friends,

We give thanks unto the Lord for His many blessings this past year. The Lord strengthened the Churches in attendance, souls and baptisms. In 2009 the total average attendance in the 57 churches and missions was 3,348 with 2,267 professions of faith and 405 followed the Lord in baptism. In the Bible College there were 17 graduated. We thank the Lord that each graduate was already committed to a place of service upon graduating. Thank you for your part and faithfulness in prayer and support for the work God has given us in Mexico.

Jan 5th began the second semester with special services in the Baptist Bible Institute. Bro. Sergio De Lira, a 2000 graduate, brought a challenging message. He is also our new Dean of Men beginning in April. Thank you for praying. We had a full house with visiting pastors, missionaries and members of our churches present. The music was great with special singing groups composed of the students. We welcomed our students back and also received four new students.



There are now 52 studying on campus for the ministry. Last year we initiated the Post Graduate course in the College. There are 22 enrolled in the course. Continue to pray for the Bible College and for God to send more laborers into His harvest.

Recently we had the blessing of visiting the Bethel Baptist Church in Cd. Mante pastored by Salvador Avalos, one of our graduates. He is doing a good job. We had good services that morning. We taught on God's Profetic Calendar in Sunday school. In the morning service, with about 110 in attendance, God moved in the hearts of the people as we challenged them to be Ambassadors for Christ. We were blessed to see the altar full during the invitation. The pastor baptized the first four in the new year during the service. In 2008 the Church averaged 91 in attendance, 47 saved and 9 baptized. Remember this Church in prayer as they continue to build for Christ.
