Dear Pastor and Friends,

Thank you for your prayers for the work in Mexico. We praise the Lord for His blessings upon the ministry of the churches, camps and Bible College this past quarter. In the Churches, there were 3,406 total average attendance with 732 saved and 141 baptized. We were involved in four different camps this summer. God gave us great victories in the three camps at the Bible College. There were 270 in senior camp, 85 in intermediate camp and 95 in the deaf camp run by Bro. David Peach. There were 117 for consecration, 11 saved and 41 that surrendered to full-time service. In another camp in which we ministered there were 45 consecrations and 13 for full-time service. Thank you for your part in prayer and support that God has used to bring forth fruit for His glory.



We look forward to a great year in the Bible College this year. There are over 30 on the list as prospective students. Pray with us that God will send us a good number to begin first year and also for the safe return of the second and third year students. Opening services will be September 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>. Pastor Abel Delgado, who was minister of music for many years here at the Bible College, and now pastor in Monterrey, will be our special speaker for the two night services; pastors Ricardo Salas from Monterrey and Samuel Osorio from Corozal will be speaking on Tuesday morning. We invite you to be with us in these special services.

Pray with us for the many needs of the ministry, especially for those of the Bible College. Besides additional monthly support we urgently need a vehicle for the college. If your church or someone in your church has a pick-up or van in good condition and would want to donate it to the Bible College we would be very grateful. The vehicle would need to be 9 or 10 years old in order for us to import it. We will need approximately \$2,000.00 for import fees and taxes.



Please pray for Sharon. As I was doing this letter, I had to admit her to the heart hospital with chest pains. The doctor says it was Acute Coronary Syndrome or a light heart attack or angina. They will be running more tests tomorrow.

Thank you again for your faithfulness. God bless you and your ministry with much fruit for His glory.
