“...the gospel of Christ...is the power of God unto salvation.” We thank the Lord for this power which has resulted in the salvation and changed lives of so many of the Mexican people. In August and September the combined average attendance in the churches and missions was 3,426 with 558 saved and 74 baptized. Thank you for your faithfulness in praying for and supporting God’s work through us. Calvary Baptist Church called Hiram Guillén, a graduate of the Bible College, as their pastor in August. We were with him for a mission emphasis Sunday several weeks ago. After the messages in the two services we passed out the Faith Promise cards with the Church promising over \$3,000.00 pesos per Sunday.

There were 169 in attendance that morning with many consecrating their lives anew and 1 saved.

Thank you for praying. God blessed the 50<sup>th</sup> opening of classes in the Bible College with a good attendance of around 800. Bro. Abel Delgado, our former music director and professor, preached soul stirring messages on Monday and Tuesday nights. We also had two other graduates that preached powerful messages on Tuesday morning. We thank the Lord for answered prayer for the twenty new students in first year. We rejoiced greatly as they gave their testimonies of God’s calling in their lives. We now have 58 students in training for the ministry. Please remember them and all the personel in the Bible College in your prayers. *“The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; pray ye therefore....*



Thank you for praying for Sharon. She is doing well after her heart attack. Looking back, we can see how God was in it all. If it had happened at home in Mexico, the outcome could have been very different. She was admitted August 12<sup>th</sup> and the next day had a double stent, end to end placed in the LAD artery of the heart. It had 98% blockage, but the doctor was able to perform the surgery without any problem in spite of the blockage being so extensive. It is mind boggling that one can have a heart attack and two weeks later is back to normal activities. God is good!

Thank you for your part in this ministry. We thank God always for you. May God bless you greatly as He continues to use you to reach the world for Christ.
