The Bible College opening was September 1-2. We were blessed with a good attendance of pastors, workers and members from our local churches. Our hearts were stirred with the excellent music prepared by our Music Director, Bro. Eli Avila. Bro. Hiram Guillen, pastor of the Calvary Baptist Church and Dagoberto Castaneda, missionary to Guatemala preached challenging messages on Monday night and Tuesday morning. Monday night we took up a special missionary offering of \$5,000.00 Pesos for them. We presented it to Bro. Dagoberto on Tuesday morning after he preached.

Missionary Offering for Guatemala

God continues to bless the churches and missions in attendance, souls saved and baptisms. This past month the total average attendance in the churches was 4,455, with 600 saved and 65 baptized. Vacation Bible Schools were held in the Churches during the past 3 months and many boys and girls were saved.

The last Sunday of August I preached to over 400 in the Bible Baptist Church. Then the next Sunday we visited the Berea Baptist Church with 65 present. Later the next week we preached in the Maranatha Baptist Church in Azucar (Sugar). Last Sunday, we visited the “God is Love” Baptist Mission, pastored by a layman, Bro. Leonardo. We rejoice in God’s blessings in each of the Churches. We have students from the Bible College laboring alongside the pastor in each of these works. We ask you to pray for Pastor Manuel and the Church in Valles which now averages 55 in attendance. Last month there were 12 saved. This past Sunday they baptized 6. They have two missions churches in other parts of the city. The Lord willing there will be another new Baptist Mission Church in the same city within a few weeks.
