There were only 8 in the first service after they lost their pastor. Two Sundays ago when we were with them they had 22 in attendance with one saved. Please continue to pray that God will provide a pastor for them. In order to maintain preaching services in the church, we have made a roll with the pastors in the area and once every four months each one of us takes a turn preaching in the services. This has been a great encouragement to the Church.

The work on the Bible college is coming along with the construction advancing. We finished the sidewalk between the auditoriums. Also, the construction of the electrical control house is finished. We still need to put in the meters and electrical connections. The last Monday of January our pastors
